Victoria loves performing all styles on music from musical theatre, cabaret, jazz, & Blues, however, she enjoys a highly successful career in the Australian Country Music Industry.

Throughout the past ten years, Victoria, has enjoyed many career highlights, performing on some of Australia's biggest stages Victoria has enjoyed much success as a cabaret artist, onboard harbour cruises, venues throughout Australia, including Star City Casino & Theatre Restaurants.

She has been special guest artist at NRL & NBL games, as well as performing at NSW Boxing Championships.

She first appeared on National Television at the age of thirteen, performing as the opening artist alongside acts such as Grace Knight & The Seekers on the 1997 NBN Telethon.

The year 2004 saw her crowned Contemporary Country Singer of the Year in the McDonalds Challenge.

Early in 2005, Victoria was selected as one of the top 5 in her age category on Channel Ten's talent search The X Factor, Over ten thousand people auditioned for the show.

Victoria was invited back to perform on the Grand Final which was live to air in May 05.

June 05' saw Victoria audition successfully for Australian Idol Series #3, from 25,000 people who auditioned for the show, Victoria was selected as one of the Top 30 contestants, giving her yet another opportunity to perform live on national television. That same year, Victoria was offered lead role at Universal Studios in Osaka, Japan.

The year 2006 bought Victoria one of her biggest career highlights to date, recording her debut album with legendary Nashville producer & guitar hero Louie Shelton, who over the past decades you would have heard Louie's signature guitar riffs, on more hit records than any other session guitarist these include, Boz Skaggs 'Low Down', Lionel Richies 'Hello', Neil Diamonds 'Play Me', The Jackson 5 hits, 'I Want You Back', 'I'll Be There' & 'ABC', The Monkees 'Valerie' & 'Last Train To Clarksville'. Louie's production credits include gold & platinum records for Seals & Croft & Lionel Richie. The album titled 'You'll Remember Me', was released during Tamworth Country Music Festival 08' & features tracks penned from some of Nashville's top songwriters, who have written for artists such as Faith Hill, Trisha Yearwood, Terri Clark, George Strait, Martina McBride, Carrie Underwood, Sara Evans & the list goes on.

After a sell out show taking to the stage with Louie for Tamworth Country Music Festival 08', in 'The Legend & The Lady', Victoria has enjoyed a whirlwind year so far, performing as special guest artist for the 'Heart & Sole' line dance ball held at Sydney Olympic Park in April.

She was the only invited country artist to perform at the 'Ashby House Line Dance Festival' held in May at West Tamworth Leagues Club, performing for over 2,000 line dancers from Australia, Singapore & New Zealand.

Victoria also headlined the 'Hunter Valleys' prestigious event 'Lovedale Long Lunch' & has just returned to Australia from performing as guest artist onboard P&O's luxurious cruise liner 'Pacific Dawn'.
